1.) Venue of the meeting:

The NMHH Visegrádi Office building is located in the Pest side, XIIIth district of **Budapest**.

2.) Registration

Online registration prior to the event is mandatory. Please indicate your intention to participate at the event at the following email address: szeregi@nmhh.hu until the 19th March 2020 5 pm.

3.) Languages

The event will be conducted in English language.

4.) Transportation

Participants are responsible for making their own arrangements for transportation to and from the event.

By public transport: metro (Line 3, Dózsa György út metro station or Árpád híd metro station), tram (Line 1 to Árpád híd metro station), or trolley bus (Line 72, 75 Dózsa György út metro station). The public transport is excellent, all stations are in 10 minutes walk distance.

By taxi: In Hungary the price* of the taxis is at a fixed tariff of 300 HUF/Km (0.95 EUR/Km) in addition to the one-off basic fee of 700 HUF (2.2 EUR) and waiting fee. A ride from the airport to the city centre should typically cost around 7200 HUF (26 EUR) depending on traffic conditions.

5.) Accommodation

Each participant is responsible for making his or her own accommodation arrangements. Pre-booking of accommodation prior to arrival is highly recommended.

The closest hotel to the venue is Danubius Hotels Helia **** (<https://www.danubiushotels.com/en/our-hotels-budapest/danubius-hotel-helia>), which is 15 minutes walking distance from NMHH's Office building.

6.) PASSPORT, VISA

Entry with personal ID card

Citizens of the following countries may enter the territory of Hungary with a personal identification card for a stay of maximum 90 days, provided the purpose of their visit is not to take up work or to conduct business-related activities: Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Holland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland.

Entry with passport, but no visa required

Citizens of European countries (with the exception of Albania, Russia, Serbia, Montenegro, Turkey and Ukraine) do not require a visa to enter Hungary.

7.) Currency

The currency unit in Hungary is 1 Forint (EUR 1 = Forints 330-340)

The major credit cards are accepted by most shops in Hungary.

Communication services in Hungary include fixed line telephony, (mobile broadband) Internet and GSM mobile telephone services. Hungary IDD Country code +36

Nationwide mobile networks are provided by Telenor, T-Mobile and Vodafone.

Hungary has a temperate continental climate. March in Budapest, Hungary, can be however versatile.

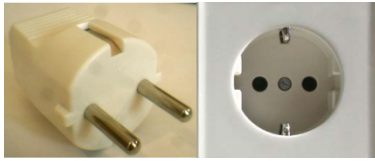
